Differences Between Events, Leagues & Trips

Event

One or more rounds

Over one or more days

One or more competitions

League

Several rounds

Over several weeks/months

One or more competitions

Trip

Several rounds

Within the context of trip

One or more competitions



Event, Round & Tournament Definitions

Event

- Contains one or more rounds
- Contains one or more tournaments
- In TPP called "Tournament"

Round

9 or 18 holes

Tournament

- Competition within a single round
- Competition spanning multiple rounds



Basic Event Structure

Divisions vs. Flights

Division

- Separate groups for scoring
- One or more divisions per event
- A player or team can be in multiple divisions
- In TPP called "Flight Group"

Flight

- Separate scoring groups within a Division
- A player or team can only be in one flight within a given Division

Sample Handicap Analysis in TM-Club

BILL SCAPLEHORN

White (121.0 / 68.4)

18.3

15

We are calculating a course handicap for All 18 holes.

The initial index is 18.3. The index is unaffacted by the maximum index setting.

This player is on the White tee, the rating is 68.4 and the slope is 121.

We calculate the course handicap as index * slope / 113 = 18.3 * 121 / 113 = 19.59. After rounding, it is equal to 20.


We apply a handicap adjustment percentage of 90%. Before rounding, the course handicap is 18.0. After rounding, it becomes 18.

Since the player is playing from a different tee than the unadjusted tee, and you are using rule 3-5, we need to adjust the course handicap. The difference in rating between the Blue and the White is -3.3 strokes, which rounds to -3. Adjusting for this, the course handicap becomes 15.

The player handicap is unaffected by the maximum handicap setting.

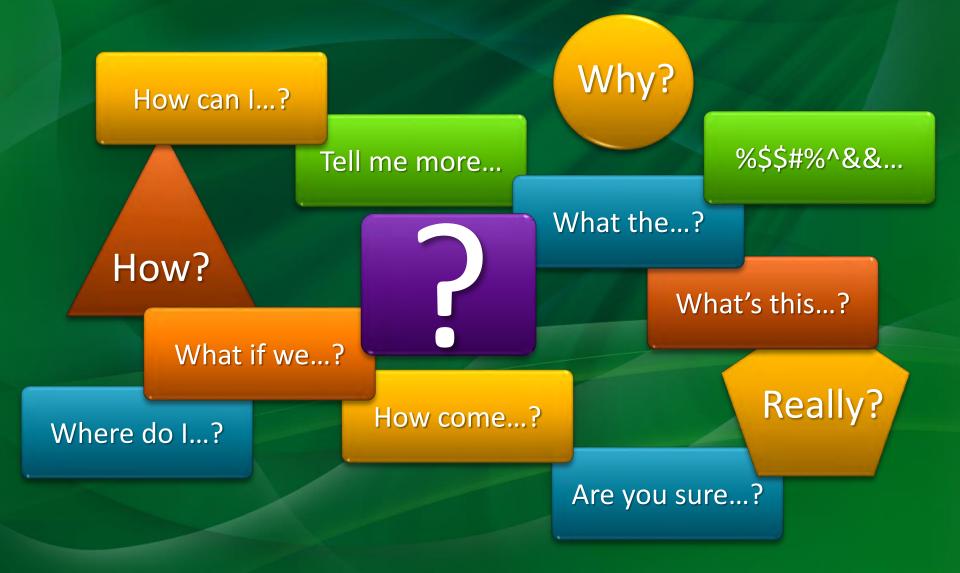
